Congratulations on your son's selection as a member of Villanova's 2017 Cross-Country team, which will compete at the annual AIC Championships, on Wednesday, 9 August at Limestone Park, Ipswich. Please find the 2017 team list attached to this letter.

A bus will transport all runners and reserves to Limestone Park on the day of the Championships. Students may attend school wearing their cross-country uniform and will complete the first two classes of the school day as normal. At the commencement of Period Three at 10.30am, the students are to meet in the quadrangle. Once assembled, a team photo will be taken before they depart the College at 11.00am.

It is imperative that all Villanova runners look like a team, therefore we expect all runners to wear the following uniform on the day of the Championships and for the team photo.
