AUGUSTINIAN PROVINCIAL CHAPTER 2018



A great event for the Australian Province of the Augustinians (including the Delegation of Korea) was the recent Provincial Chapter held at St Augustine's College, Sydney, 2nd-6th July, 2018. These chapter meetings, which are major events in the life of the Province, occur every four years (with a Midchapter of review occurring midway in the four year term).

Major directions to emerge from the 2018 Chapter:

- Commitment to a planning process to prepare for establishing the first Augustinian community in Vietnam in 2019.
- Commitment to ongoing renewal of Augustinian community life.
- Support for a renewed effort in vocations promotion locally.

The Chapter was an uplifting experience of Augustinian fraternity as most of the Augustinians living and ministering in Australia and some from South Korea gathered for the meeting. Our brotherhood is diverse in age and cultural heritage but united in heart and mind as we seek to follow the Gospel.

At the beginning of the Chapter, the Prior General , Fr Alejandro Moral Anton OSA confirmed Peter Jones in the position of Prior Provincial.

TEN YEARS AT AUGUSTINIAN VOLUNTEERS

In 2008, the Augustinian Order in Australia made the momentous decision to establish a Volunteer organisation so that young (and not so young) lay adults could experience the Church's thrust towards ministry with the poor and marginalised and the personal transformation that comes from this service.

Since then over 100 young people have participated in the program with at least a year of volunteering somewhere in Australia or overseas on behalf of the Augustinians.

Many of our Augustinian Volunteers have returned for a second or even third year. We have one Volunteer who has been with us for over 8 years. Invariably our Volunteers relish their year of 1, 2 or even 3 days per

week, working with us in a ministry with a Refugee or Indigenous community to build resilience and participation in the educational and employment sectors.

Our most recent big-ticket involvement has been to assist young Indigenous people in Sydney recover and speak the language lost to them at the time of colonisation in this country.

The Augustinian Volunteers in Australia are learning about the loss of human dignity referred to by Pope Francis where some people in our world are being treated as "leftovers" (Laudato Si).
