Of this population, there are around 22 families and over 30 persons living alone. The youngest is a 3month old baby, while the oldest is 75 years old who has been living alone and a street dweller for the past 30 years.</p> | <p>*No reported cases at present *As most residents fish and farm, they don't need to travel to Cebu. *Island nurse still needs to travel to Daanbntyan-northern city on the mainland to sterilise her equipment *She said about possibility of contracting Covid-19 whilst on mainland - "I am worried but it's a call of duty, Sir. Wear my mask" *AFAS Elders trying to <i>fundraise money to purchase a steriliser as they will not be travelling to Kinatarcan in 2020.</i></p> |
