

AIC RUGBY LEAGUE 2020

In 2020 the AIC Rugby League season will be in a tournament style format with multiple games being played over a one or two day period. The tournaments will be played as follows:

- Year 7-12 teams (2-day tournament) – **Monday 21 and Tuesday 22 September** hosted by Iona College (during the school holiday period). Schedule to be confirmed.
- Years 5 & 6 (1-day tournament) – **Friday 18 September** hosted by Marist College Ashgrove during school time (boys will be transported to and from the venue). Schedule to be confirmed.

AIC Rugby League Uniform

After the teams have been selected, boys will be asked to purchase the Rugby League uniform.

Any student who represents the College in Rugby League must wear the full College Rugby League Uniform. Jerseys will be issued by the staff from the Uniform Shop. The College will notify all players regarding the collection of their jerseys from the Uniform Shop; this will be done via morning notices. Note that all players must purchase the new rugby league shorts (\$45). The normal hire cost of the jersey (\$20) will be waived this season.

The uniform includes:

- Villa Rugby League Shorts (not PE shorts nor the Football shorts)
- Villa Rugby Socks (same as Rugby Union and Football socks)
- Villanova Rugby League jersey. This jersey will be made available through the College Uniform Shop. Students will be required to collect their own jersey during Week 10 once the coaches have

confirmed team selections. A complete list of all teams will be given to the staff at the Uniform Shop. There will be no hire cost for the jersey this season.
