## Will your child be catching the bus to/from School in 2021? Applications are now open for 2021 Bus Passes!

Dear Parent or Guardian,

Bus passes are available for those students who meet the distance eligibility criteria for a State Government subsidy towards travel costs going to and from school.

## New applications from existing bus pass holders are also required if:

- > Your child is entering Prep or Year 7 in 2021
- > Your child is starting at a new school in 2021
- Your address has changed

Bus Travel Assistance applies to students who meet the distance eligibility criteria:

- High School student who resides 4.8km, or more, from the nearest State High School
- Primary School student who resides 3.2km, or more, from the nearest State Primary School.

Please note that the distance criteria applies whether your child attends that school or not.

**Bus Travel Assistance Safety-Net (SN)** applies to new applicants who do not meet the distance criteria above, but are listed on a Pension or Health Care Card and meet the following criteria:

- High School student who resides less than 4.8km from nearest State High School.
- Primary School student who resides less than 3.2km from nearest State Primary School.

Details of the Pension or Health Care card must be supplied.

If your student currently holds a Transdev bus pass and none of the criteria above apply, a new card will be sent to your student's school for the commencement of Term 1 2021. Alternatively, these bus passes can be collected from the Transdev office at 10 Smith St Capalaba from 21 December 2020 - 15 January 2021. Office hours are Monday -Friday 8:30am – 4:30pm.

New applications must be submitted by **11 December 2020** to ensure your child has their bus pass to commence the 2021 school year. Due to the volume of new applications received, applications received after this date could result in a delay in your child receiving their bus pass, and they may be required to pay full fare to travel.
