Dear Parents / Care Givers

Families will now be aware of the recent announcement by the Chief Health Officer and Queensland Government of an extension of the current lock down through until 4.00pm Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> August.

During the next four days Villanova College teaching staff will be providing online lessons for all students as per the attached Learning@Home timetable.

#### **Directions for Students to follow**

- 1. Get dressed for Online Learning by wearing your Sports Uniform (if you do not have a House Shirt wear Villanova College Apparel)
- 2. Prepare all the materials you will need for the upcoming lessons before 8.30am
- 3. Start up your computer and ensure Teams is open
- 4. Accept the invitation from your teacher when a Teams meeting is initiated
- 5. At 8.30am Year 5 and 6 students will begin the day with a pastoral meeting with their teacher. Years 7-12 will begin the day with a Form Meeting with their respective Pastoral Area Leader.
- 6. For the pastoral meeting keep camera off and mute on
- 7. For all other lessons camera on and mute on

To assist parents to be familiar with the TEAMS Platform I have attached a one-page information sheet for families. If your son does have difficulties tomorrow do not worry. Mr John Christie, Dean of Teaching and Learning will continue to keep students informed of their assessment requirements as we navigate this week.

#### **Students of Essential Workers**

The Chief Health Officer has been very firm in emphasising all Brisbane residents must stay at home unless it is absolutely essential to attend work. The College will have a small number of staff available to supervise any students whose parents/caregivers have no option but to send them to school over the next four days, but I ask that this only be as a last resort, in line with the directions of authorities. If your son/s require supervision at school on either Wednesday, Thursday or Friday please complete the link below by 4.00pm Tuesday 3rd August.

Students attending school are asked to sign in at the Student Services Desk - Senior School - St Thomas of Villanova Learning Centre before 8.30am each morning. Students will be expected to be dressed in their full school uniform, including a mask, and to have all their required equipment and materials for work. Students will be directed to a classroom and assigned a desk based on social distancing requirements.

In line with the Chief Health Officer's request this morning that people not leave home unless it is absolutely critical, **students are not permitted on site to collect any materials.** Textbooks are accessible online and students have been asked to ensure their laptops are taken home each day. ## Set up a learning environment

## **Open Microsoft Teams**

You can use Teams from most web browsers or by downloading the app.


