Program Structure

The program is divided into 3 parts:

Preparation: including an exploration of reasons for going, building of background

knowledge of the history and context, preparation for cross-cultural

interactions, fundraising.

Immersion: the two weeks in the Philippines.

Return and action: debriefing the experience and exploring ongoing supported action back in our

own community at Villanova College.
