Explanation of College Fees:

Application Fee is payable on submission of a formal Application for Enrolment. This fee is non-refundable.

Tuition Fees:

- Confirmation Fee - To confirm the offer of a place at Villanova College, payment of the Enrolment Confirmation fee of A\$900 along with the signed Written Agreement must be received before the student commences their study.
- Tuition Fees – includes tuition and the following:
 - costs of excursions, year level camps and retreats, sport affiliation costs, coaches and buses
 - miscellaneous materials and services supplied directly to students, e.g. textbooks, online subscriptions, photocopied resources, art, woodwork and hospitality supplies
 - Building Maintenance Levy – supports ongoing maintenance of College facilities

Non-Tuition Fees:

- Overseas Student Health Cover: It is a visa requirement that all international students have private health insurance, covering the duration of their visa. There are numerous providers, however the College suggests BUPA [Overseas Student Health Cover Insurance \(OSHC\) | Bupa](#) to provide this cover. It is ultimately the student's responsibility to maintain the cover and know their provider details. A copy of the Certificate of Insurance must be provided to the College Enrolments Officer before commencing at the College. The cost provided is an indicative charge only.
- Uniform Costs – Initial cost of approximately \$1,000 and some ongoing replacement costs may be required. The College Uniform Shop is managed by Alinta Apparel and the uniform price list is available at <https://shop.alintaapparel.com.au/>. The cost provided is an indicative charge only and will need to be met by the student as/when incurred.
- Stationery – includes general stationery as required for specific subjects. The cost provided is an indicative charge only and will need to be met by the student as/when incurred.
- Laptops – Students at Villanova College are required to bring their own device to school. Please refer to the BYOD Information included in the Enrolment Package for information on specifications, installation of software and requirements for specialist subject areas in the Senior School. The cost provided as in an indicative charge only.
- QCCA Levy (Years 11 and 12 only)

*Explanation of Homestay (Australian Homestay Network - AHN) Fees:

- Placement Fee – Charge payable on initial placement and if a student requests a change of Homestay provider.
- Airport Pick-up/Transfer – covers the cost of student pick-up and transfer to their homestay address. Charge is per transfer.
- Homestay Fees/inclusions: Separate bedroom containing a comfortable bed with bed linen, wardrobe, study desk, good lighting and ventilation and laundry facilities. The Homestay family will provide three meals per day.
- Homestay exclusions: Bus, train fares, parking and tolls. Visa renewal or personal entertainment.
- NB "Total Homestay Charges" displayed on the previous page is indicative only and based on an average of 18.5 weeks per semester. This takes into account the below optional Homestay room holding rate for the 2 week mid semester break only.
- Optional Homestay charges include: Homestay room holding rate is \$195 per week.
