# Carnival Information

Date: Sunday 20 October

Time: 8:00am-2:30pm – See attached Draw.

Venue: Marist College Ashgrove Pool- enter via Glenlyon Drive. Limited parking in pool car

park. Street parking is available in surrounding streets.

Divisions: Year 7, Year 8/9 and Opens (excludes Year 12).

Eligibility:

All AIC Member College and AIC Guest College – Ambrose Treacy are eligible to enter teams.

Year 7- must currently be in Year 7 at the school. Year 8/9- must currently be in Year 8 or 9 or below at the school Opens - must currently be in Year 11 or below at the school.

Players may play for a Year 7 or Year 8/9 team in the morning and are permitted to play in the Open competition in the afternoon.

Year 12 students are not eligible to play.

Referees: Water Polo Queensland will provide referees for all games.

Score Table Duty: All schools will be allocated score table duties have been allocated throughout the day.

Teacher/Coaches: All teams must be accompanied by a teacher/coach who is responsible for the team during each game.

Canteen: A Canteen will be in operation on the day.

School Tents: Schools may bring their own school tent.

First Aid: A First Aid Officer will be available at the venue.

### EXTRA CARNIVAL INFORMATION/RULES

### 1. Carnival Rules.

Standard Water Polo rules will apply except for timings and exclusions.

### 2. Team Size.

All games will be seven-a-side (6 field players and 1 goalkeeper)

Teams are only to consist of a maximum of 13 players.

# 3. Team Uniform and Equipment

Teams must have the availability to wear blue or white caps (light or dark caps).

## 4. Ball Size

Year 7 and Year 8/9- Size 4

Open - Size 5

# 5. Carnival Format.

Year 7 and Year 8/9 – Gala type Round Robin Matches. No finals will be held.

Opens: Round Robin competition with a 'finals' cross over.

## 6. Game Length

Games will be 2 x 8 minute running time halves with 1 minute half time.

No possession time clocks will be used, however, the referee has the ability to penalize a team for "Time Wasting".

### 8. Exclusions

Any player EXCLUDED by the referee must swim to the designated exclusion area and then may return to the field of play OR be substituted.
